Stop SB 320 - Don't Make Colleges Into Abortion Clinics February 2018

Sacramento – Senate bill SB 320, *On-campus student health centers: abortion by medication techniques* (Leyva – D. Chino) would require each public university and college student health center to offer abortion by medication. The bill states "*Abortion care is a constitutional right and an integral part of comprehensive sexual and reproductive health care. Abortion by medication techniques is extremely safe, highly effective, and cost effective."* These statements on their face are false and dangerous. Calls to state legislators are needed now to stop this perverse and misleading bill.

SB 320 goes far beyond the purview of legitimate government, which is to protect its citizens. What kind of message would this bill send to unmarried students? "Go ahead and indulge in premarital sex and we will provide you with medication to abort any subsequent pregnancy." The 'medication' is self-administered. It makes the pregnant woman the abortionist. She will feel and quite likely see its results.

The chemical used, RU-486, has a bad track record of physical harm, including death, to the user. Our legislators should be aware of this, it has been known for years. RU-486 use requires a two-step process of starving the unborn baby to death and a subsequent chemical application for expulsion of the dead child.

SB 320 would avoid the cost to abortionists of privately owned clinics used for surgical abortions and shift costs to publicly funded on-campus student health centers used for chemical abortions. Proponents of SB 320 include Planned Parenthood and other abortion providers and advocates.
